Board of Directors' February 11, 2026, Meeting Minutes

1. **CALL TO ORDER:** Board Solicitor Richard Shoch, Esq. called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.
2. **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**
3. **ROLL CALL:**

4. **RECOGNITION OF GUESTS/PUBLIC COMMENT:** Charley Hall, Muncy Borough Manager thanked WBRA for their crew's help cleaning up the recent heavy snow and recent residential fire.
5. **APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES:** January 22, 2026: A **motion** to approve meeting minutes of January 22, 2026, was made by Ed Feigles and seconded by Debra Stine. ***The motion passed unanimously. Motion carried.***
6. **APPROVAL OF BILLS /TREASURER'S REPORT:** A **motion** to approve January's Treasurer's Report was made by Ed Feigles and seconded by Rick Kneedler. ***The motion passed unanimously. Motion carried.***
7. **OLD BUSINESS:**
 - a.) **Chippewa Resident letter update:** The board was provided a copy of the corrective action plan requested made by WBRA to Muncy Creek Township Supervisors regarding issues with Chippewa Road septic systems.
 - b.) **Heating System update:** Jimmy Herr provided the Board with an update regarding heating issues and necessary repairs at the WBRA building. Eco Air submitted a proposal in the amount of \$155,000 to convert the system to natural gas. The proposal includes extensive ductwork and the installation of multiple heating units throughout the building. Jimmy is currently awaiting additional quotes from other contractors. Discussion also included the possibility of installing a boiler system for heat; however, this option would not provide air conditioning.
8. **NEW BUSINESS:**
 - a.) **Penn Bid for Route 54:** Recent issues with the Penn bid submission included questions regarding installing or not installing a fence around the pump station, as well as other necessary clarifications. As a result, Penn Bid issued an addendum to address these matters. Bids are scheduled to be opened on Monday. If the submitted bids are too high, the project will need to be rebid. Engineer Tom Levin has prepared the plans, contract documents, and permit application for submission to PennDOT in anticipation of a possible rebidding process.

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9. DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

1. 2026 projects include:
 - Wagner Avenue's sewer replacement. This may be coordinated with the water line project with Point Township. Johnny will know more about the water line at tomorrow evening's Point Township meeting.
 - Muncy Sewer Trunk Line
2. Per approval by Brady Township, WBRA will begin preparation of the Act 537 Plan and Water Quality Management Permit to allow connection to WBRA's system. Brady Township recently applied for a water/sewer grant to fund the connection to WBRA's system. WBRA was awarded grant funding; however, Brady Township was not. Discussions will continue regarding applying for additional grant opportunities to support tying Brady Township into WBRA's system as WBRA's system grows closer to Brady. Currently, Brady Township customers pay \$55 per month for sewer service.
3. The County Landfill has requested a meeting to introduce the new direction and discuss prices. Todd, Rocky and Debra expressed interest in attending the meeting with Johnny.

10. **SOLICITOR REPORT:** None.

11. **ADJOURNMENT:** With no Further public business to conduct, a motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 7:26pm.
