Notes To Property Owners:

- A current tapping/ capacity fee of \$1,500.00 per EDU will apply (**unless this qualifies officially as a re-connect, then a \$32.00 re-connect inspection fee applies**) and must be paid prior to discharge to WBRA's sanitary sewer system. Partial EDU's will be rounded up to the next whole number.
- Monthly sewer billing by the Authority will begin the first of the month following occupancy. The property owner will be responsible for notifying the Authority when they occupy the structure (and for all sewer charges incurred at the above property). Failure to do so will result in back billing from the date on this form.
- The property owner hereby indemnifies the WBRA from any and all damages that may result from the property owner choosing not to install a running trap or proper ventilation.
- **The property owner hereby acknowledges that connections to the sanitary sewer that allow for ground water or stormwater (e.g., sump pumps, floor drains, foundation drains, down spouts, etc.) to enter the public sewer system are not permitted.**
- The property owner hereby indemnifies the WBRA from any and all damages that may result from the property owner choosing not to encase a sewer lateral which is located within a horizontal distance of less than 50 (fifty) feet from a water well (or similar water supply source).
- Discharging sewerage to the public sewer system without proper application to WBRA is considered theft of services and will be prosecuted as such.
